Pursuant to the Order Granting in Part and Denying in Part Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment, Intervenors' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment and Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that summary judgment is entered in favor of defendants with respect to the biological disclosure, part of the medical risk disclosures, and the medical emergency exception.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that partial judgment is entered in favor of intervenors with respect to the biological disclosure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that judgment is entered in favor of plaintiffs with respect to the relationship disclosures and part of the medical risk disclosures.

As a result, defendants are permanently enjoined from enforcing SDCL 34-23A-10.1(1)(c), (d), and (e)(ii) and that portion of (e) that references “statistically significant risk factors.”
